



CARES & Special Needs Children

[CARES](#) (Child Aviation Restraint) was recently approved by the FAA for use with older children with special needs. Parents of children with special needs often run into problems when they fly because their specially-designed car seats either do not fit properly on the plane, or are not FAA-approved. So, instead of lugging a bulky car seat through the airport, parents can grab the 1lb. CARES device that provides all of the safety of a car seat, without any of the hassle. CARES was originally designed for children 22-44 lbs. (1-4 years old) who sit in their own plane seats, but now older children with special needs can get permission to use the device too.
